VINEYARD DETAIL

OUR CHENIN BLANC IS GROWN IN POPE VALLEY IN THE NAPA VALLEY AVA. OUR 3 ACRE VINEYARD, PLANTED IN 1945, SITS AT AN ELEVATION OF 750 FEET ABOVE SEA LEVEL AND YIELDS AN AVERAGE OF 3 TONS PER ACRE ANNUALLY.
