TASTING NOTES

ON THE NOSE, THE RICH, POWERFUL AND LUSCIOUS PURE BLACK CURRANT, PLUM AND RASPBERRY FRUIT TONES COMPLEX WITH BUTTERY, TOASTY OAK. A RICH AND CONCENTRATED ENTRY TO THE PALATE LEADS TO AN AMPLE AND WELL BALANCED WINE WITH REFINED ELEGANCE AND EXCELLENT PERSISTENCE.
